### **Outreach Initiatives completed during this period:**

- 1. Job Fairs:
  - a. Towson University Communications, Media, and Marketing Expo- February 22, 2023. WTMD & WYPR's Senior Director of HR & Director of Marketing & Strategy provided a booth and met with job seekers looking for opportunities in the industry.
  - b. Current Public Media Virtual Career Fair March 29, 2023. WYPR's Interim CEO, Executive Director of News, & Senior Director of HR provided a booth and met with job seekers looking for opportunities in the industry.
- 2. WYPR Newsroom Partner with Report for America (RFA) and the Anthony Brandon Fellowship Fund (ABFF) Fellow June 2022 Report for America is a national service program that places journalists into local newsrooms to report on under-covered issues and communities. An initiative of the nonprofit media organization, The GroundTruth Project, it is structured to harness the skills and idealism of an emerging group of journalists plus the creative spirit of local news organizations. The first RFA News Reporter is also the second Fellow from the ABFF. The ABFF was created with an aim of broadening opportunities for students of journalism and to enhance recruiting diverse and talented individuals from a variety of backgrounds and experiences to our station.
- 3. Continuing Education to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions:
  - a. July 18-22, 2022, WYPR & WTMD staff participated in the Greater Public's Public Media and Development Conference in Chicago, IL.
  - b. April 26-27, 2023, WYPR General Assignment Reporter attended Campaign Journalism Conference The University of Chicago Institute of Politics (IOP) and the Nieman Foundation for Journalism at Harvard announce the 2024 Campaign Journalism Conference for reporters covering the 2024 races for control of state legislatures, Congress and the White House. During the intensive two-day boot camp, leading political consultants, academics and veteran journalists from across the U.S. will share their expertise to help journalists at small, medium and large outlets learn the practical tools and skills necessary to effectively cover political campaigns as well as local and national elections and that are increasingly becoming more complex.
- c. (September 2022 August 2023) Digital Transformation Project through Poynter Institute, funded by CPB: 10 staff participants
- 4. Provided for training to staff on methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination.
  - a. Reimagine Racial Equity conducted by Conscious Collaboratory Eight-week course offered to WTMD and WYPR Management and staff on a rotating basis. The first of three 8 week sessions included four participants between September 20, 2022 to Nov 8, 2022, and the second included three participants ran between January 17- 2023 March 7 2023, the third included three participants ran between April 4, 2023 May 23, 2023.
  - b. In the fall of 2022, every WYPR & WTMD employee was required to participate in CPB's online harassment prevention training course. This course was designed to increase an employee's awareness and knowledge of applicable laws surrounding harassment prevention and the impact these laws have on current job responsibilities. Both WYPR & WTMD had 100% employee participation in this training.

- c. The Assistant Chief Engineer has completed the following training: 2/26/23 GVF500 Ed 2.2 Introduction to Satellite Communications, March 5 2023 GVF505 Ed. 1.1: RF and DC Theory for Satellite Systems, 2/22/23 Broadcast Network Technologist Certification from SBE, Ongoing GVF510 Ed2: Core Skills for VSAT Professionals.
- 5. Internship Programs designed to assist in acquiring skills needed for broadcast employment or volunteering. Students get exposure in many departments including Programming, News, Interactive, and Development departments. Open to the public, college students, our programs offer opportunities to intern over a period of time and acquire broadcasting skills, knowledge, and experience. We teach, challenge, and prepare our interns for broadcast careers. Our internships have been a recruitment tool as we have hired former interns.
  - a. November 2021 marked the 13th year **WYPR partnered with Cristo Rey Jesuit High School** which provided an opportunity for minority students to acquire broadcasting skills and knowledge. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, Students interned virtually this year in one or more of the following departments: Programming, News, Membership, Maryland Morning, Midday, and the General Manager's Office. WYPR hosted one intern this term.
  - b. The Bryn Mawr School for Girls of Baltimore Senior Project WYPR Hosted one intern between May 16 May 30, 2023. Founded in 1885, Bryn Mawr School is a non-sectarian, independent, all-girl day school for children in pre-kindergarten through grade twelve. The program over the two weeks, provides an opportunity for the student to explore interests heretofore inaccessible to them. It is expected to be a time for "stretching", experimentation, and independence. The program will expose the intern to broadcast industry skills, inclusive of multimedia production, audio editing, and web, communication.
- **6.** WTMD provided employment information at the First Thursday Concert on June 2, July 7, August 4, & September 1, 2022. This event is a summer series over five months the station produces. Information about current opening and employment procedures were available on-site. Interested individuals met with station management staff about careers in broadcasting.
- 7. Staff Outreach in events or programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting sponsored by educational and community institutions.
  - a. WTMD's Interim Station Manager hosted Towson University Electronic Film & Media students for a tour and Q & A in May 2023.
  - b. WYPR's Senior Producer Creative Content during the 2022/2023 school year taught a weekly "Podcasting Fundamentals" class to high school seniors at Baltimore School for the Arts. The students learned interviewing skills and editing techniques, and they designed and produced their own original podcasts.
  - c. WYPR's Senior Producer Creative Content during the 2022/2023 school year taught a monthly podcasting workshop for a cohort of high school students in the Elijah Cummings Youth Program. The students produced episodes for the "Social Justice is not Just Us" podcast series. Their topics included immigration, housing justice, the school to prison pipeline, and advocacy for survivors of sexual violence.
